Here's the info you need to participate in the services. We hope very many of you will.

1. Google ZOOM and download the software now. It is free. ZOOM will ask you to set up an account and to create a password. If you don't have a computer, not to worry. It is also possible to participate by phone and you will be contacted with the number.
2. The links to each service are embedded above. But also, a day or so before the service, you will receive an email with a reminder of the link to the service. You click on that link and enter ZOOM with your email/password. A dialogue box will appear saying "open zoom"; the meeting will launch and you click "join meeting". Phone participants will call the number provided. The meeting will be open from 9:30 on each Sunday.
3. You will be able to see, hear, and talk to all if you are using a computer. If you are participating by phone, you will be able to hear and talk, but not see the

others. The service will be as “normal” as possible: hymns, readings, joys & concerns, etc.
