Rev. Terry's service will call our attention to the Gaelic ritual cycle observance of Imbolc, February 1st. It celebrates the midpoint between the winter solstice and the vernal equinox, embodying the increasing daylight and the gradual return of warmth. The image below shows traditional symbols for Imbolc.
